These Academic years were vibrant with activities and filled to the brim with achievements.

ABOUT OUR COLLEGE

Our college is a member of "GOJAN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS" family, sprung up to cater the needs of the socially, economically and educationally backward region of Redhills and for those aspiring to become teachers. We see to that no stones unturned for providing the best of everything in Teacher Education. The college has been offering Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) a one year programme in the branches of Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical sciences, Biological sciences, History, Geography, Commerce, Economics, Computer science, Sociology and Psychology from the academic year 2008-09 and Master of Education (M.Ed.) a one year programme from the academic year 2010-11. At present we are functioning with 100 B.Ed., students, 35 M.Ed., students with fully qualified staff.

INFRASTRUCTURAL DELIGHTS

The college is well located in the 80 feet road of Edapalayam, near by RedHills and is well connected through roads and public transport systems. College buses provide easy transportation to the students and the staff across the Chennai city and nearby suburban areas.

The college Infrastructure facilities includes state-of-art Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Psychology, Educational Technology, Language, Computer laboratories, SUPW and Music rooms, Guidance and Counselling and Placement cell, a Multi purpose hall, Spacious class rooms, Voluminous library, Indoor and Outdoor games facilities in vast playgrounds.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Our college carries a record of impressive achievements in the academic front. In the Academic year 2010-11 B.Ed., batch, out of 100 students, 99 passed out and our pass percentage was an impressive 99%. Five students obtained distinction in Theory exams and 80 students passed in First class. All the students appeared for practical exams passed in Distinction. Overall, First place was bagged by Smt. G. Anitha of Commerce & Accountancy Department, Second place was by Shri. B. Santharaj of Commerce & Accountancy Department and the Third place by Smt. R. Kalyani of Mathematics Department.

In the 2010-11 M.Ed., batch out of 35 students, 33 passed out and our pass percentage was an impressive 94%. 23 students passed in First class in Theory exams. Two students appeared for Dissertation passed in Distinction and 28 passed in First Class. The First place was bagged by Smt. S. Gangadevi, Second place by Shri. R. Sridhar and the Third place by Shri. S. Chandrasekar.

In the Academic year 2011-12, out of 99 students, 98 passed out and our pass percentage was again an impressive 99%. Seven students obtained distinction in Theory exams, and 81 students passed in First class. 97 students appeared for practical exams passed in Distinction. Overall, Smt. N. Premavathy of English Department bagged the First place, Smt. P. Indhira of History Department, Second place and Smt. P. Kavitha of Physical Sciences Department and P. Jamuna of English Department bagged the Third place jointly.

In the 2011-12 M.Ed., batch out of 35 students, 33 passed out and our pass percentage was an impressive 94%. 25 students passed in First class in Theory exams. Ten students appeared for Dissertation passed in Distinction and 25 passed in First Class. Overall, First place was bagged by Smt. L. Padmaja, Second place by Smt. P. Jacintha Mary and the Third place by Smt. G. Anitha.
